



***Incursion:***

*Prep – Grade 6 Gymnastics – Tri Skills, P.E. Classes - 3<sup>rd</sup> June to 24<sup>th</sup> June.*

***Educational purpose:***

*From the 3<sup>rd</sup> June to the 24<sup>th</sup> June we have organised Tri Skills Gymnastics to provide a 3 week gymnastics program for all students from Prep to Grade 6 during P.E. sessions. This program will be run by qualified gymnastics instructors and all equipment will be provided by Tri Skills Gymnastics.*

*This program has been heavily subsidised by our sporting schools funding grant and as a result will only cost \$6 per student. This includes use of equipment, qualified instructors and 3 sessions.*

*There are two main reasons we have decided to look at obtaining an outside company to come in and run a gymnastics program at MEPS.*

- 1. We do not have the equipment available at school, the monetary requirements to purchase the equipment required or the space to store the equipment at school.*
- 2. Gymnastics is a higher risk activity and it is therefore important to have qualified staff to run the program. We will then have MEPS staff to act as supervisors and assistants to the qualified trainers and therefore enable students to have more individualised support. This will also provide more opportunities for students to be challenged at their level of ability.*

*When students have been informed about the gymnastics program in class there has been genuine excitement from students so it promises to be a very successful program that all students will enjoy.*

***Supervising staff:***

*P.E. Teacher and integration aides*

***Cost: \$6***

***Activity list:***

- Participating in a range of gymnastics activities provided by qualified staff with all equipment supplied.*

***Student accident insurance:***
